\*Foundations Requirement: 12 hours of graduate coursework comprising (i) any BEF or BEP classes or (ii) any other non-research method courses outside of the student's department. Approved by the program of study committee, these classes are intended to introduce the theoretical discourses and bodies of knowledge that provide a depth and breadth of understanding necessary for fluency with research, theory, and scholarship foundational to the student's field of inquiry and dissertation research.

### GRADUATE SCHOOL Ed.D. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum of 60 semester hours of course credit beyond the Master's degree or minimum of 90 Semester hours of course credit at the graduate level.
- Minimum of 12 semester hours of dissertation research credit.
- Time limits: 6 years before admission; 7 years after admission.
- Transfer rule: up to one-half of course credit (not to include dissertation research credit).

Note Regarding Program Policy: At the discretion of the program of study committee, up to 18 hours (6 AEL courses) of the Ed.S. major may count as part of the 36-hour major for students pursuing an Ed.D. degree.

The EdD program planning committees consist of a minimum of three members, one of whom must be from outside the program in which the student is enrolled.
